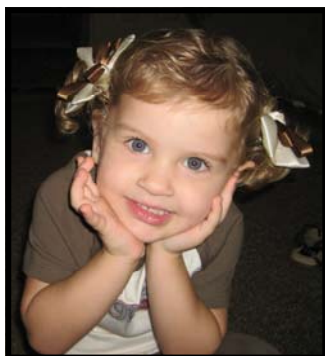

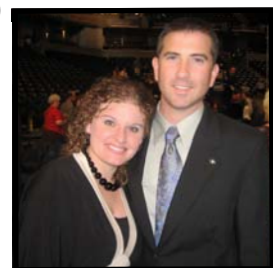
Lynzi...the MK!
